Programme Outline Level 2:

The Level 2 VRQ Diploma in Hairdressing provides the necessary skills and knowledge that prove competence as a junior stylist.

This qualification allows candidates to learn, develop and practice the skills required to provide hairdressing services for all hair types.

The Level 2 VRQ Diploma in Hairdressing covers a range of skills and knowledge such as cutting, drying, styling, colouring and lightening, relaxing and perming as well as shampooing and consulting with clients.

To achieve a Level 2 each candidate must complete 7 mandatory units and 3 optional units and complete a mandatory work experience.

Programme Outline Level 3

The Level 3 Advanced Technical Diploma in Hairdressing is based on the National Occupational Standards for Hairdressing.

It is a job ready qualification which requires learners to demonstrate in the workplace the skills and knowledge required in the hairdressing industry. This qualification attests to a high level of occupational competence and the job readiness of the learner.

You will need to have completed Level 2 hairdressing and have literacy skills at level 2 or working towards Level 2.

To achieve a Level 3, each candidate must complete 5 mandatory units, plus 3 optional units.

During the course students will cover elements from

- Setting and dressing hair
- Styling and finishing hair
- Changing hair colour
- Plaiting and twisting hair
- Fulfilling salon reception duties
- Advising and consulting with clients
- Cutting women's hair
- Colour correction
- Cutting men's hair

Progression: You could progress into employment or a higher level apprenticeship to continue your learning.
